AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Judge of the Farmington Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L. 1931, c. 41, relating to Farmington municipal court; judge's salary increased. The last sentence of chapter 41 of the private and special laws of 1931, is hereby amended to read as follows: 'The judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of ~~eight hundred dollars~~ **\$1200** in full.'
