AN ACT Relating to Aid for Private Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 136, amended. Section 136 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new sub-section, to be numbered VI-A, and to read as follows:

'VI-A. So that not exceeding 5% of the taxes collected by the municipality from taxpayers located on abutting property on any private road may be expended for the improvement of, maintenance of, or snow removal from said private road.'
