AN ACT Relating to Official Inspection Stations for Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1939, c. 169, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 169 of the public laws of 1939 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 2. Certain garages may be licensed as official inspection stations. Upon written application giving such description of the garage and its equipment as may be required by the secretary of state, the secretary may license such garage as an official inspection station located as to convenience the public for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of section 1 hereof. No application as an official inspection shall be made unless garage and equipment shall comply with the provision of the secretary, to wit: a garage building to be used as an inspection station shall be at least 40 feet in length **and 12 feet in width**, and shall have a level floor and shall be equipped with a screen or chart for the purpose of testing lights, and with tools and machinery necessary to make repairs to motor vehicles. Before granting an application for license as an official inspection station the premises shall be examined by a member of the state police, and the operator investigated as to his reliability and fitness for such appointment.'
