### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Amending the Law Relating to Unemployment Compensation to Reduce Benefits When Claimed Fraudulently.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1935, c. 192, § 5, additional. Section 5 of chapter 192 of the public laws of 1935, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new subsection (f), to read as follows:
- '(f) For any week for which he is found to have filed a claim fraudulently to obtain benefits to which he is not entitled, and his maximum benefit amount shall be reduced by an amount equivalent to the number of such weeks of disqualification times his weekly benefit amount.'
