AN ACT Relating to Hearings on Applications for Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. L., 1937, c. 237, § 25, amended. Section 25 of chapter 237 of the public laws of 1937 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following :

'In the event that information is presented to the liquor commission to show that the above section has not been complied with, the commission shall revoke such license.'
