AN ACT Relating to Hotel Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. L., 1935, c. 179, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 179 of the public laws of 1935, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following :

‘The commission shall provide in their rules and regulations so that in those cities and towns in which daylight saving time has been adopted that persons, firms or corporations having a hotel license may operate under their license according to daylight saving time.’
