STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Rules and Regulations of the State Racing Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P. L., 1935, c. 130, § 10, amended. Section 10 of chapter 130 of the public laws of 1935, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 'Sec. 10. Rules and regulations. Said commission shall make rules and regulations for the holding, conducting and operating of all harness horse races or meets for public exhibition held in this state and for the operation of race tracks on which any such race or meet is held. No such race or meet shall be permitted on Sunday. During the month of July a meeting may be allowed for not exceeding 12 days on mile tracks. During the years 1943 and 1944, pari mutuel races may be conducted on the Maine state fair track at Lewiston, Maine, on holidays and Saturdays between the dates of May 1st and November 1st.'
- Sec. 2. Limitation. This act shall be in effect for a period of 2 years only.
