STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Temporary Insurance Agency Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 60, § 125, amended. Section 125 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Upon the death or disability of a licensed agent or the termination of the employment of an agent, the insurance commissioner may issue to a suitable person without examination a license for a limited period of time, not to exceed 6 months to act as an agent, if in his opinion such temporary license is necessary for the continuation of the business of the agency thereby affected.'
