STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Land for the State School for Girls.

Commissioner of Institutional Service authorized to purchase certain land. Resolved: That the commissioner of institutional service, with the approval of the Governor and council, be authorized to purchase approximately 28 acres of land in the city of Hallowell for use of State School for Girls and the sum of \$1,150 be, and hereby is, appropriated for that purpose.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The State School for Girls is in need of more land for the production of hay and for pasturage, and this seems a good opportunity to procure additional land at a reasonable price. The present policy is to raise more young stock than formerly to replace animals that can no longer be kept with profit. Two parcels of land near the institution farm are available for \$450 and \$700, respectively.
