STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Designation of Inland Fisheries and Game Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Fish and game wardens renamed. The inland fisheries and game wardens shall hereafter be designated as "conservation officers".

Wherever in the statutes the words "wardens" or "warden" appear relating to a warden or wardens of the department of inland fisheries and game, they are hereby changed to "conservation officers" and "conservation officer", respectively.
