IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Somerset County to George H. Cook, Ir., and Howard H. Chase.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to George H. Cook, Jr., and Howard H. Chase, both of Leominster, Massachusetts, in equal shares, whatever interest the state has in lots 87, 88 and 89 in Big W, N. B. K. P., containing 22 acres, more or less, for the sum of \$1,208.36.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land was formerly assessed to Albert A. Tisdale, et als and was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1923 for 1921 taxes. Messrs. Cook and Chase, who were former part owners, are desirous of obtaining these lots by paying the taxes in arrears. The taxes in arrears with interest and cost to 1942, inclusive, amount to \$1,208.36. Certified check for this amount is in the hands of the treasurer of state.
