AN ACT Relating to the Disposition of Tax-Acquired Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Disposal of property acquired by tax process. Unless the town by vote otherwise directs, the municipal officers may sell or dispose of real estate acquired by the town by tax forfeiture process on such terms as they deem advisable, and may execute quitclaim deeds for such property, and may assign unmaturred tax lien certificates. A vote of the town directing the manner in which such property shall be sold shall continue in effect until the town by vote otherwise directs.
