STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Unexpended Balances of School Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 216, amended. Section 216 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 216. Disposition of unexpended balances of school fund. All unexpended balances of the state school fund or of any funds or appropriations deducted therefrom shall, at the close of the year for which said fund or appropriation is available, be added to the permanent school fund of the state carried forward as a part of the state school fund of continuing appropriations for the ensuing year. Balances at the close of the fiscal year deducted from the state school fund and set apart for certain activities may be transferred from one division to another by consent of the governor and council; provided, however, that balances in any fund made up jointly from funds deducted from the state school fund and appropriations from the general funds of the state shall be disposed of in accordance with the foregoing part of this section.'
