**AN ACT to Accept the Benefits of an Act of Congress to Provide for the
Promotion of Vocational Education.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1931, c. 216, Art. V, § 5, amended. Section 5 of Article V of chapter 216 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 5. Vocational education board. There shall be a vocational education board consisting of the commissioner of education, the commissioner of health and welfare, ~~and~~ the commissioner of labor, **the commissioner of agriculture, and the head of the department of home economics of the University of Maine,** to cooperate with the federal board of vocational education. The commissioner of education shall be chairman of this board. The members shall serve without compensation.'
