AN ACT Relating to Fees of Town Clerks for Issuance of Fishing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 19, ¶ (4), amended. Paragraph (4) of section 19 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘(4) Each season license shall expire on December 31st of the calendar year in which it is issued. Each agent shall on the 1st of each month forward to the commissioner the net funds by him collected, together with a report containing a list of the persons to whom he has issued licenses since last report, the class of each license; and said funds shall be promptly forwarded to the treasurer of state; **provided, however, that if less than 10 licenses have been sold in a single month, the cost of money order and postage to send such money to the commissioner shall be subtracted from the amount the agent has collected and the balance shall be sent forward to the commissioner as above provided for each license.**’
