## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

#### RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Cambridge Pond.

Fishing in Cambridge pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Cambridge pond in Cambridge, county of Somerset, to ice fishing for pickerel only from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring.

Committee Amendment "A" to H. P. 88, Resolve "Regulating Fishing in Cambridge Pond."

Amend said Resolve by striking out in the second from the last line thereof the following words:

'for pickerel only'

and by adding after the last word thereof the following underlined words:

"for pickerel, hornpouts, white perch, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts."
