STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Authorizing the Department of Health and Welfare to Regulate
Public and Private Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 1, additional. Chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 12-A and to read as follows:

'Sec. 12-A. Public and private institutions regulated. The department shall inspect all public and supervise and license all private institutions and private boarding homes providing assistance, care, or other direct services to children who are neglected, delinquent, defective, or dependent, as well as to the aged, the blind, and other dependent persons.'
