IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

**AN ACT to Regulate the Sale and Packing of Sardines During the Present
Emergency.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. L., 1933, c. 2, § 24, affected. Sardine packing regulated. The 1st sentence of section 24 of chapter 2 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby suspended until January 1, 1946.

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 41, § 73, affected. The last sentence of section 73 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby suspended until January 1, 1946 and the following enacted in place thereof for that period:

'Beginning January 1, 1943, the licenses for the calendar years 1943, 1944, and 1945 shall run from January 1 to December 31 of the respective years, unless sooner revoked as herein provided.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 41, § 77, affected. Packing fee. The 1st sentence of section 77 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby suspended until January 1, 1946, and the following enacted in place thereof for that period:

'Each packer shall pay monthly, not later than the 10th day of each month, ~~one cent~~ 1½c per case on the amount of sardines packed during the previous month, toward the cost of maintaining the inspection provided for in section 76 and as a part of the fee for obtaining and retaining his license.'

Sec. 4. P. L., 1941, c. 318, repealed. Chapter 318 of the public laws of 1941 is hereby repealed.
