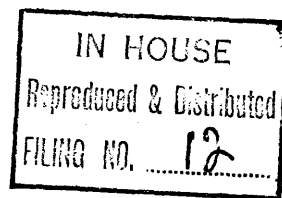

# ORIGINAL

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 32, L.D. 27, Bill "An Act  
Relating to Penalty for Night Hunting."

Amend said bill by striking out all after "\$50" in the 9th  
line thereof, and inserting in place thereof the following:

'not less than \$100 and costs, nor more than \$200 and costs,  
which fine and costs shall not be suspended, and an additional  
penalty of not more than 30 days in jail, at the discretion of the  
court; and for a 2nd or subsequent offense, by a fine of not less  
than \$200 and costs, nor more than \$400 and costs, which fine and  
costs shall not be suspended, and an additional penalty of not  
more than 60 days in jail, at the discretion of the court.'
