Committee Amendment "A" to H. P. 65, L. D. 50, Bill "An Act Relating to Casualty and Surety Insurance Rate Regulation".)

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection IV of that part designated "Sec. 292" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'IV. Workmen's compensation insurance. Provided that the filings required by subsection II of section 6 of chapter 26 may be made on behalf of any Workmen's Compensation insurer by a rating organization licensed in accordance with the provisions of section 296.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the ^{1st} 2nd line of that part designated "Sec. 295" the ^{underlined} word "finds" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'has reason to believe'.
