HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 65, L. D. 50, Bill "An Act Relating to Casualty and
Surety Insurance Rate Regulation."

Amend said bill by adding at the end of subsection IV of that part designated
"Sec. 292" the following:

'The filings required by subsection II of section 6 of chapter 26
may be made on behalf of any workmen's compensation insurer by a
rating organization licensed in accordance with the provisions of
section 296.'

Further amend said bill by striking out in the 2nd line of that part designated
"Sec. 294" the following words "and at the request of the commissioner".

Further amend said bill by striking out all of subsection V of that part
designated "Sec. 294" thereof and inserting in its place the following:

'V. Beginning ninety days after the effective date of
sections 291 to 309, inclusive, no insurer shall make
or issue a contract or policy except in accordance
with filings which are in effect for said insurer as
provided in sections 291 to 309, inclusive, or in
accordance with subsections III or IV of this section.'

Further amend said bill by striking out in the 1st line of that part designated
"Sec. 295" the word "finds" and inserting in place thereof the words "has reason
to believe".
