RESOLVE, in Favor of Willis C. Foster, of Reading, Massachusetts.

Willis C. Foster; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$158.25 to be paid to Willis C. Foster, of 120 Middlesex Avenue, Reading, Massachusetts, as a full and final settlement of all claims for damage to his car by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident occurred on November 16, 1946, at 8 A. M. in the town of Cherryfield and was investigated by Warden Wallace E. Barron. Mr. Foster's car was damaged to the extent of a bent right front fender; broke grill; broke both headlights, lenses, reflectors, bulbs and brackets; bent radiator cowling; 27 sq. inches of radiator mashed by the fan.
