

MAINE STATE LEGISLATURE

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Senate Amendment "A" to H.P. 1631, L.D. 1306, Bill "An Act
Relating to Reciprocal Contracts of Indemnity."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of the 1st sentence
of that part designated "Sec. 210" the following underlined words:
'; provided, however, that the provisions of subsection III of
section 41, requiring companies to do ^{insurance} business in this state by
constituted agents resident herein subject to its laws, and the
provisions of sections 249 to 256, inclusive, relating to insurance
agents and brokers, shall not apply to the attorney-in-fact of a
reciprocal or inter-insurance exchange nor to the traveling
salaried home office representatives of such exchanges operating
on a salary basis and receiving no commissions, but any reciprocal
or inter-insurance exchange that operates under the agency system
in this state and appoints agents on a commission basis shall be
subject to and conform to the provisions of the sections herein-
above mentioned'
