STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Permitting the Building of a Bridge Between Burnt Island and Spruce Head Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Bridge between Burnt Island and Spruce Head Island, permitted, Samuel F. Langdell and his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are hereby authorized and empowered to construct and maintain a bridge over tide water between Burnt Island, so called, and the southerly shore of Spruce Head Island, in the town of South Thomaston, county of Knox. Provided that construction of such bridge shall be commenced within 2 years after the effective date of this act.
