Committee Amendment "A" to H. P. 118, L. D. 82, Bill "An Act to Provide a Town Council and Manager Form of Government for the Town of Limestone in the County of Arcostock.

Amend said Bill by inserting after the Title thereof, the following:

"Emergency preamble. Whereas, the annual town meeting of the town of Limestone is held during the month of March, and

Whereas, the people of Limestone desire to vote upon the acceptance of a town council and manager form of government at its annual town meeting, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now therefore,"

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof, the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.'
