RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Aroostook County to Gerard Albert of St. Agatha.

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Gerard Albert, of St. Agatha, whatever interest the state has in an undivided interest in lot 13 and half lot 14 in N. half, according to plan of N. half by Joseph Sewall in 1886, in T. 17, R. 4, W. E. L. S. Aroostook county, containing 110 acres, more or less, for the sum of \$430.10.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This tract of land was sold November 27, 1936 for the 1934 taxes. Gerard Albert, of St. Agatha, wishes to purchase this property for the sum of \$430.10 which is the amount of back taxes, interest and cost. This amount has been deposited with the treasurer of state.
