RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Land in Aroostook County to Maxime J. Michaud, of St. Agatha.

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Maxime J. Michaud, of St. Agatha, whatever interest the state has in lot 12 in N. half, according to plan by Joseph Sewall in 1886, with buildings, in T. 17, R. 4, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county, containing 25 acres more or less, for the sum of \$199.44.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This tract of land was sold November 23, 1937 for the 1935 taxes. Maxime J. Michaud wishes to purchase this property for the sum of \$199.44 which is the amount of back taxes, interest and cost. This amount has been deposited with the treasurer of state.
