STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of T. E. McSherry, of Sweden.

T. E. McSherry; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$476 from the appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to T. E. McSherry, of Sweden, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his apple orchard by deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This damage was done during the winter of 1944-45.

Damage is as follows:

289 trees @ \$1.25 \$361.25

These trees are in one field and are about 30 years old. The branches on these trees came down to the ground. The deer had eaten the buds and fruit spurs off as high as a man could reach.

153 trees @ .75 \$114.75

These trees were not damaged as badly as the above, but a good part of the fruit spurs and buds were eaten off as high as a deer can reach.

Total amount of damage \$476.00
