IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Superintendents of Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 71, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 71 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 350 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Upon approval of said certificate, the superintendent so employed shall, on presentation of proper vouchers, receive monthly out of the sum appropriated for superintendence of towns composing school unions a sum equal to the aggregate sum paid by the towns composing the union, provided that the amount so paid for the benefit of a single union of towns shall not exceed ~~\$1,200~~ \$1,500 in one year nor shall any school union receive less than ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,300 per year.'
