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**AN ACT Amending the Charter of the City of Lewiston Relating to the  
Election of Aldermen.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. II, § 3, repealed and replaced.** Section 3 of article II of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 3. Election of aldermen. Election of aldermen shall be by plurality. In case of a tie vote, there shall be held a special election to be known as a run-off election in such ward on the 1st Monday in March next thereafter, and only the names of those candidates who received a tie vote shall be placed upon the ballot, in alphabetical order.’
