RESOLVE, in Favor of Benjamin H. Jones, of Woodland.

Benjamin H. Jones; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$101.50 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Benjamin H. Jones, of Woodland, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On November 8, 1945, Mr. Jones' car was damaged considerably when it struck a deer on route No. 9 in the town of Woodland. It was investigated by Game Warden Harland Hitchings.
