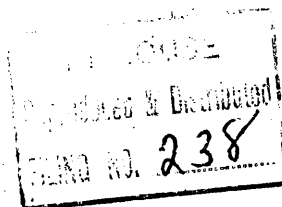
# ORIGINAL

Committee Amendment "A" to H.P. 195, L. D. 140, Bill

"An Act Permitting Towns to Appropriate Money in Anticipation  
of State Appropriations."

Amend said bill by adding at the end thereof, the following under-  
lined sentence:

'Provided, however, that the state highway commission may at any time,  
from appropriate funds, reimburse towns for expenditures previously  
made for the improvement of state aid roads, provided such expendi-  
tures have been made with the consent of the state highway commission  
and under its supervision, and that such reimbursements in any year  
shall not exceed the apportionments made to such towns for the  
improvement of state aid roads under existing statutes.'
