Senate Amendment "A" to S. P. 478, L.D. 1336, Bill "An Act to Increase State Aid to Towns for the Support of Schools to Establish Minimum Salaries for Teachers."

Amend said Bill by striking out, in subsection II of that part designated "Sec. 201", the 10th, 11th, 12th and 13th lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

'approved by the commissioner, ~~the~~ a budgetary balance after deducting subsidy as above mentioned, which shall provide an amount sufficient to allocate to each municipality, units, as hereinafter determined, which shall be not less than \$100 each, based on the effort made'
