Senate Amendment " B " to S.P. 478, L.D. 1336, Bill "An Act to Increase State Aid to Towns for the Support of Schools to Establish Minimum Salaries for Teachers."

Amend said Bill by striking out the underlined figures "\$450" in lines 1 and 2 of subsection II of section 201 and inserting phrase 'not less than \$400 nor more than \$450'. 

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined figures "\$100" in line 13 of subsection II of section 201 and inserting in place thereof the underlined figures '\$90'.

Further amend said Bill by drawing a line through the phrase "12-te-26-mills" and inserting after said phrase the underlined phrase '15 to 29 mills' in line 16 of submection II of section 201.

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined phrase "\$1,800 or \$2,000" in line 27 of subsection II of section 201 and inserting in place thereof the underlined phrase \$1,700 or \$1,800'.

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of subsection II of Section 201 the following underlined paragraph:

'In the event of insufficient appropriation to finance the foregoing provisions, the commissioner of education is authorized to make allocations to towns in the same ratio that total funds available are to total prescribed apportionments for teaching positions."

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined figure "\$1,800" in line 15 of subsection II of section 204 and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure 1\$1,7001.

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined figure "\$2,000" in line 17 of subsection II of section 204 and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$1,800'.
