Committee Amendment "A" to H.P. 250, L.D. 176, Bill,
"An Act to Incorporate the Town of Litchfield School
District."

Amend said bill by striking out the entire
"Emergency preamble" therein, so that said bill shall
commence with the enacting clause.

Further amend said bill by striking out the entire
second paragraph of Section 8 titled "Emergency clause;
effective date of act; referendum," and inserting in
place thereof the following new paragraph:

Effective date of act; referendum. This act shall
take effect when accepted and approved at a regular town
meeting or a special meeting of the legal voters of the
territory embraced within the limits of said district
called and held for the purpose not later than 1 year
after the approval of this act. Such special election
shall be called, advertised and conducted according to
law relating to municipal elections, provided however, that
the selectmen in the town of Litchfield shall not be required
to prepare for posting or the town clerk to post a new list
of voters, and for the purposes of registration of voters,
said selectmen shall be in session 1 hour preceding such
election. The Town clerk shall reduce the subject matter
of this act to the following question: "Shall the act to
incorporate the Town of Litchfield School District be
accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by ballot the

words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. The result in said district shall be declared by the municipal officers of the town of Litchfield and due certificate filed by the town clerk with the secretary of state.
