

# MAINE STATE LEGISLATURE

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Committee Amendment "A" to S. P. 98, L. D. 197, Bill "An Act Relating to School Committee in Town of Rumford."

Amend said Bill by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 3, to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Referendum. This act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of this legislature only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the town of Rumford at any regular or special town meeting of such town. Such meeting shall be called for that purpose by an appropriate article inserted in the call for the meeting. The town clerk shall prepare the required ballots for the meeting, upon which he shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall 'An Act Relating to School Committee in Town of Rumford', passed by the 93rd legislature, be accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by a cross placed over the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This act shall take effect for all the purposes of this act immediately upon its acceptance at the above meeting. The result of the vote shall be declared by the municipal officers and certificate thereof filed by the town clerk with the secretary of state.'
