

This document was scanned by the staff of the Maine State Law and Legislative Library from the files of the Maine State Archives. Committee Amendment "A" to H. P. 342, L. D. 215, Bill "An Act to Incorporate the Brunswick Sewer District and to Transfer to It the Sewers of the Brunswick Village Corporation."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 4 thereof a new section to read as follows:

'<u>Sec. 5.</u> Procedure in crossing public utility. In case of any crossing of any public utility, unless consent is given by the company owning or operating such public utility as to place, manner and conditions of the crossing within 30 days after such consent is requested by said district, the public utilities commission shall determine the place, manner and conditions of such crossing; and all work on the property of such public utility shall be done under the supervision and to the satisfaction of such public utility, but at the expense of the district.

Provided, however, nothing herein contained shall be construed as authorizing said district to take by right of eminent domain any of the property or facilities of any other public service corporation or district used or acquired for future use by the owner thereof in the performance of a public duty, unless expressly authorized herein or by subsequent act of the legislature.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 to be sections 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13, respectively.

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 2nd line of section 10 thereof the figure "7" and inserting in place thereof the figure '8'.
