COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 444, L.D. 262, Bill "An Act

Providing for Fire Escapes with the Approval Thereof of the Insurance Commissioner or Fire Inspector."

Amend said bill by striking out in the 9th and 10th lines thereof, the underlined words: "or as a workshop, manufactory" .

Further amend said bill by striking out in the 11th, 12th and 13th lines thereof, the following underlined words: "or of a building used in any way not named above but which has a similar need of such protection as determined by the insurance commissioner or fire inspector" .

Further amend said bill by striking out in the 16th and 17th lines thereof, the underlined words: ", in the opinion of the insurance commissioner or fire inspector," and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'reasonably' .

Further amend said bill by striking out in the 5th, 6th and 7th lines from the end thereof, the following underlined sentence: "A ladder affixed to any of the premises herein described shall not be considered a fire escape within the meaning of this section."
