Committee Amendment "A" to H.P. 612, L.D. 377, Bill "An Act to Incorporate the Town of Van Buren School District."

Amend said bill by striking out the entire "Emergency preamble" therein, so that said bill shall commence with the enacting clause.

Further amend said bill by striking out in the second line of section 6 thereof the figure and word "60 days" and inserting in place thereof the figure and word ¹⁶6 months/¹.

Further amend said bill by striking out after the designation "Sec. 7" thereof the title "<u>Effective Date</u> of October Referendum,", and inserting in place thereof the new underlined title "<u>Referendum Provided</u>."

Further Amend said bill in section 7 thereof by striking out in the fifth line (third and fourth lines of bill as printed) the figure and words "60 days after the approval of this act" and inserting in place thereof the following figure and words '6 months after the effective date of this act.'

Further amend said bill by striking out all of Section 9 thereof, entitled "Emergency clause."
