Committee Amendment "A" to L.D. 440 H.P. 684 "An Act to Incorporate the Freeport Sewer District."

Amend Section 3 of said bill so that the head note shall read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Percedure in exercise of right of eminent domain and crossing public utilities'.

And Further amend said Section 3 by adding the following paragraph thereto:

In case of any crossing of any public utility, unless consent is given by the company owning or operating such public utility as to place, manner, and conditions of the crossing within 30 days after such consent is requested by such district, the public utilities commission shall determine the place, manner and conlitions of such crossing; and all work on the property of such public utility shall be done under the supervision and to the satisfaction of such public utility, but at the expense of the district.

And further amend said bill by striking out the figures "500,000" in the 8th line of section 17 thereof and inserting in place thereof the following \$ '250,005'

And further amend said bill by striking out the underlined words "; town relieved from duty relating to sewers" in the 2 nd and 3rd lines of the head note of Sec. 19.

And further amend said bill by striking out the word "Eleven" in the 30th line of Sec. 20 thereof and inserting the following: 'Twenty per cent of the '
