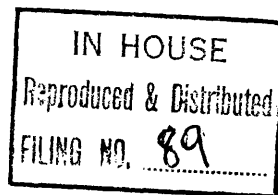
Committee Amendment "A" to L.D. 442, H.P. 686 Bill, "An Act to Incorporate the Corinna Water District."

Amend said bill by striking out the word "appointed" which appears in the 3rd line of Sec. 6 thereto and inserting in place thereof the word 'chosen'

Further amend said bill by striking out all of the 3rd sentence of Section 6 thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:  
'Whenever the office of a trustee becomes vacant for any cause other than the expiration of its term, the municipal officers of the town of Corinna shall appoint a successor to serve for the unexpired term.'

Further amend said bill by striking out all of the 2nd sentence in Sec. 7 thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:  
'Thereafter one member shall be elected at each annual meeting of the district to serve for a term of 3 years.'

And further amend said bill by inserting <sup>in the 3rd line of Sec. 11</sup> after the words "time to time," the following:  
'not to exceed \$150,000,'
