Committee Amendment "A" to 'L.D. 562, H.P. 946, "An Act to Incorporate the Yarmouth Sewerage District."

Amend said bill by striking out the words "East Main" in the 8th line of Sec. 1 thereof and inserting the following word 'Spring'

And further amend said bill by striking out the word "Spring" in the 8th line of Sec. 1 thereof and inserting the words 'East Main'

And further amend said bill by adding after the word "drainage" in the 36th line of Sec. 1 thereof the following: 'and to provide for disposal of sewage in whole or in part by other means than emptying it directly into the ocean or into rivers or streams, when such disposal units become necessary'

Section 2 of

And further amend/said bill so that the head note thereof shall read as follows:

'Sec. 2. Procedure in exercise of right of eminent domain and crossing public utilities'.

And further amend said Section 2 by adding the following paragraph thereto:

In case of any crossing of any public utility, unless consent is given by the company owning or operating such public utility as to place, manner, and conditions of the crossing within 30 days after such consent is requested by such district, the public utilities commission shall determine the place, manner and conditions of such crossing; and all work on the property of such public utility shall be done under the supervision and to the satisfaction of such public utility, but at the expense of the district.

And further amend said bill by adding, after the word "district" in the 5th line of Sec. 9 thereof, the following: 'and the rates, rules and regulations of this district shall be subject to approval of the public utilities commission'

And further amend said bill by striking out the figures "1947." in the 5th line of Sec. 17 thereof and inserting the following:

'1948, but if and only if the total number of votes cast for and against the acceptance of this act in said election equals or exceeds 20% of the total vote for all candidates for governor cast in said district, at the next previous gubernatorial election.'
