HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 285, L. D. 804, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Fees for Licenses for

recreational or overnight camp has been licensed during the previous
year, the fee for such license shall not exceed \$5.'

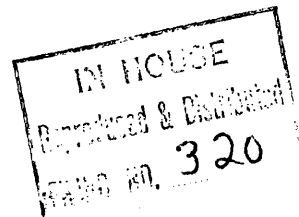
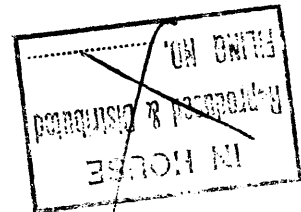
