Senate Amendment " A " to S.P. 322, L.D. 870, Bill "An Act Relating to Police Commission of the City of Lewiston."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Local Referendum; effective date. This act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of this legislature only for the purpose of permitting its acceptance or rejection by the legal voters of the city of Lewiston at the next regular city election. For the purposes of such election the city clerk shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall the Act Relating to Police Commission of the City of Lewiston be accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by a cross placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This act shall take effect for all the purposes hereof immediately upon its acceptance by a majority vote of the legal voters voting at said election. The result of said vote shall be declared by the municipal officers of the city of Lewiston and due certificate thereof filed by the city clerk with the secretary of state.'
