Committee Amendment "A" to S.P. 318, L.D. 874, Bill,  
"An Act Amending the Charter of the City of Lewiston".

Amend said bill by striking out the entire  
"Emergency preamble".

Further amend said bill by striking out that part of  
section 4 designated as "Sec. 15" and inserting in place  
thereof the following: 'Sec. 15. Salary of police  
officials. The salary of the captains of police, the  
captain of detectives, the lieutenants of police and  
police clerk shall be fixed by the police commission,  
subject to the approval of the board of finance.'

Further amend said bill by striking out the entire  
"Emergency clause".
