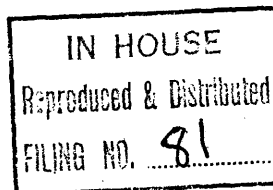

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1264, L. D. 935, Bill, "An Act Instructing the Commissioner of Education to Establish and Grant State High School Equivalency Certificates."

Amend said Bill by inserting in line 2 of the second paragraph thereof after the ^{underlined} word "veterans" a ^{underlined} ', ' (comma) and in the same line after the ^{underlined} words "veterans, or" the underlined word ^{underlined} 'to' and word ^{underlined} "Honorably"

Further amend said bill by striking out the ^{underlined} period in the sixth line of paragraph 2 thereof and inserting in place thereof the underlined words:

'by the commissioner except that ^{underlined} honorably'
