COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1289, L. D. 943, Bill "An Act
Relating to Auctions and Auctioneers."

Amend said Bill by striking out of the headnote in the
first paragraph the ^{*underlined*} section number "82-G", and inserting in
^{*the underlined section number*} place thereof, '82-H'.

Further amend the first paragraph of the Bill by striking
out the figure "7" and inserting in place thereof the figure '8',
and by striking out the number "82-G" and inserting in place
thereof '82-H'.

Further amend said bill by adding at the end thereof the
following new paragraph:

'Sec. 82-H! Blooded animals may be sold without state license.
The provisions of sections 82-A to 82-G, inclusive, shall not prohibit
any person employed by the owner of blooded animals from selling the
same as auctioneers at public auction whether licensed by the state
or not.'
