Committee Amendment "A" to S.P. 368, L.D. 1042, Bill  
"An Act Relating to Elections in the City of Biddeford."

Amend said bill by striking out in the 8th line  
(6th line as printed) of section 5 the underlined  
figure and word "1 year" and inserting in place thereof  
the underlined figure and word '2 years'

Further amend said bill by striking out in the  
9th line (8th line as printed) of section 7 the under-  
lined word "alderman" and inserting in place thereof  
the underlined word 'councilman'

Further amend said bill by striking out in the  
17th line of that part of section 7 designated as Sec.  
2, the <sup>underlined</sup> word "Alderman" and inserting in place thereof  
<sup>underlined</sup> the word 'Councilman'.
