House Amendment " A " to H.P. 1446, L.D. 1051, Bill "An Act to Incorporate the Town of Dixfield School District."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 9 thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 9. Emergency clause; effective date; referendum. In view of the emergency recited in the preamble hereof, this act shall take effect when approved, only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the territory embraced within the limits of said district at a special meeting thereof called and held for the purpose not later than 4 months after the approval of this act. Such special meeting shall be called, advertised and conducted according to law relating to municipal elections; provided, however, that the selectmen in the town of Dixfield shall not be required to prepare for posting or the town clerk to post a new list of voters, and for the purposes of registration of voters, said selectmen shall be in session the 3 secular days next preceding such ~~meeting~~ meeting. The town clerk shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall the act to incorporate the Town of Dixfield School District be accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by a cross placed over the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This act shall take effect for all the purposes thereof immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters voting at said meeting.

The result in said district shall be declared by the municipal officers of the town of Dixfield and due certificate thereof shall be filed by the clerk of said town with the secretary of state.'
