# ORIGINAL

Committee Amendment "A" to H.P. 1463, L.D. 1067, Bill,  
"An Act to Create the Caribou School District."

Amend said bill by striking out the last two sentences in the third paragraph of section 3 and inserting in place thereof the following, 'The treasurer shall give bonds or notes to the district in such sum and with such sureties as the trustees may determine, which bonds or notes shall remain in the custody of the president. The cost of such bonds or notes shall be paid by the district.'

Further amend said bill by striking out at the end of line 5 and beginning of line 6 (line 5, as printed) of section 4 the words "at any one time outstanding."

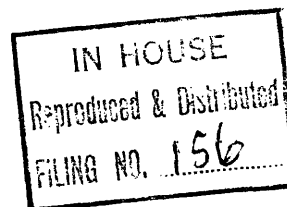
Further amend said bill by striking out in line 6 of section 5, before the "%" sign, the figure "2½" and inserting in place thereof the figure '4'.
